

- The increasing proportion of women faculty members to more than 33.3%
- Women occupy over 34% of the faculty members in medical sciences
 Women occupy over 60% of teachers nationwide
- 97% of age groups from 10 to 49 years have overcome illiteracy
- Lower literacy gap of 6.1% between men and women
- Lower literacy gap of 11% between urban and rural areas
- Eradication of gender-based gap in education at two primary and intermediate levels nationwide
- Women compose over 56% of university students nationwide
- Girls' enrollment growth rate at primary level by 115%
- Girls' enrollment growth rate at high school level by 84%
- **48%** increase of girls' students as compared to boys
- Increase in women's access to education in 784 technical and engineering fields
- around 588502 women occupy a total number of university admissions nationwide in 2022
- Women compose 24% of the inventors nationwide

- Iranian Women in Science and Education
- The increasing proportion of women faculty members to more than 33.3%
- To every 100 women nationwide there are 60 midwives and 2.8 gynecologists
- 95% of all birth deliveries are taken place by women gynecologists
- The implementation of nationwide health coverage for 100 of the urban and 99% of rural areas
- Life expectancy has increased to 78 years of age
- Women engage 98% of gynecologists nationwide
- Women engage in 40% of medical specialists and 30 % of GPs
- Women occupy half of the medical staff
- Iran holds 10th rank in having the least rate of cervical cancer in the world
- Decrease in the maternal mortality rate to 16 per 100 thousand live births
- Decrease in the neonatal mortality rates to 8.2 per 100 thousand live births
- Decrease in mortality rate of children below the age of 5 to 14.2% per 100 thousand live births
- Full vaccination for 95% of children
- Around 90% of children up to first year, 80% to 1.5 and 40% to 2 years of age enjoy breastfeeding

4 Iranian women and economic participation




- - A number of 345 laboratories out of the total of 1424 laboratories of the national lab networking are directed by women (24%)
 - A number of 20 companies are chaired by women in 13 entities out of 25 in the market and industrial sector (52%)
 - 904 women are managing directors of knowledge- based companies
 - 303 companies are chaired by women
 - 250 knowledge- based companies are established by women
 - 2390 women are members of board of directors for knowledge -based companies
 70 accelerator companies in various areas are chaired by women
 - Women employers compose 1.2 of all women employees
 The number of women employers equal 32783
 - Number of women cooperatives nationwide equal 5776
 Women of 15 years and above engage in over 13.3% of economic participation
 - Rate of unemployment decline to 16%
 Women's employment share in the private sector in 2022 equals 75.5%
 - Women's employment share in the public sector in 2022 equals 25.5%
 - Women's employment share in the service sector in 2022 equals 57.5%



- Women's employment share in the industrial sector in 2022 equals 75.5%
- Women's employment share in the agricultural sector in 2022 equals 17.2%
- Plan to promote employment for rural and nomad women
- Implementation of national plan for family oriented sustainable businesses in order to join job- seekers to jobowners and markets
- Allocating land to women machineries and increase in women's access to natural resources through women cooperatives equaling to 2000
- Sustainable business development through systematic microscale businesses for rural and nomad women based on the LNSIE model and creating 4200 micro scale funds
- Membership of over 60000 rural and nomad women in 2000 rural and nomad cooperatives
- Training of over 300000 rural and nomad women annually with the implementation of entrepreneurship promotion plans and sustainable business development with the aim of promoting sciences, engineering and technology training
- Social service insurance coverage for rural and nomad girls and women
- Social service insurance coverage for women housewives
- Social service insurance coverage for women-headed households



- Allocating 1% of the two season budgets of the executive organizations in 2021 to women's affairs in addition to allocation of budget to the vice - presidency for women and family affairs

Iranian women in political, power and decision- making areas





- Women compose 49% of voters in the presidency elections
- Women compose 49% of nominees in the sixth rounds of the elections for the Islamic Council in rural and urban areas
- Women compose over 11307 of nominees in the sixth rounds of the elections for the Islamic Council in rural and urban areas
- Over 1000 women work as judges
- Increase of women nominees by 2% in the sixth elections of the councils and 3% increase in the previous elections
- Women's active participation in parties and political groups (more than 5 thousand)
- Establishment of 7 special parties on women's affairs (15 women are members of the founding board of these parties)

- 25.2 % of directors nationwide are women at all levels of high ranking, intermediate and executive directors
- A woman is the vice-president for women and family affairs
- More than 1000 women are working as judges
- 227% increase in women nominees at the 11th round of parliament
- The rate of women's representatives in the parliament have increased 16.5times
- over 111 seats of the parliament have been occupied by women during the 11 rounds





- Women athletes have won 3829 medals in various international events
- Women won 878 world medals since the beginning of the 13th government
- Women participated in 173 international sports events in 2021 and have won 1036 medals
- 934589 women are engaged in professional sports activities
- 85 women are active in international communities
- 150384 women are engaged as sports trainers
- 96998 women work as referees
- 8965 women work as trainers in women gym clubs
- 16111 women are working in women gym clubs
- 51 women are active as chairs and vice chairs of the sports federations
- 70 women are working as chair of the board of directors at provincial levels
- 97 seats are engaged by women in international sports federations
- Holding of 1876 training courses for women sports trainers in 2021
- Training 548 women referees in 2021





- Over 23543 women are writers and 1051 work as publishers
- 435 women across the country run printshops and publication offices (153 women work in Tehran as the highest number)
- 181479 women are authors with work permit to printing books
- 2336 women are engaged as media editors
- 903 women are active as film makers
- 2000 women are working in professional backstage cinema activities
- during the past 5 years over 1708 women have received work permit as media editors
- Women's active participation in IT has increased by 31.5%
- Women filmmakers have won 114 national awards and 128 international awards
- Women filmmakers' participation in 45international festivals as jury
- Increase in women's share in access to technology, information and communication
 - 26 million women have access to mobile phones (45% of total mobiles)
 - 14.5 million women have access to the computers (48% of total computers)
 - 18.7 million women have access to the internet (48% of total internet users)

- Key measures undertaken in the area of IT
- Key measures Increase in the number of domestic and commercial internet users to more than 11 million people in 2021
- Fiberoptic distribution at national level and the increase by five times the internet speed in order to offer new VDSL internet services
- Easy access to mobile internets and increase by 13% to mobile internets in 2021
- (Currently there are over 132million mobile users registered in the country) Increase in the mobile internet speed from 4G to 5G
- Offer internet packages to professors, teachers, students during the pandemic in order to support online teaching
- Access of more than 47000 villages to land line telephones and mobile coverage in more than 95% of the main roads (Source: Ministry of IT)






- Women held the position of president of the National environment organization 4 times
